Bro. Jason MacRae had just left the bank and was on foot looking for a certain hardware store in Bacolod to purchase some paint supplies for a room in his house. Along the way, a car pulled up beside him, and the driver lowered the window. The man inside the car asked Bro. MacRae if he was looking for something, and offered Bro. MacRae a ride. Through their conversation, Bro. MacRae found out that the driver, Dr. Occena, is a professor at West Negros University here in Bacolod and the director of the Institute of Languages. Jason shared his desire to have Bible studies with college students, and Dr. Occena was very interested. West Negros University is the largest college in our city and happens to be a private college that was founded after WWII by three Baptist women. The college is owned by the same family today, and their preference is that all ministering to the students on the campus be done by "Baptists."

Dr. Occena gave Bro. MacRae a tour of his office and the campus, as well as introduced him to many of the staff and faculty of the school. They were very interested to learn that Mrs. MacRae has her Masters of English degree from Hyles-Anderson College, as they are desperately in need of native English teachers for their school. Dr. Occena is going to help us to get an appointment with the ministerial director at the school.

Please pray that through this contact we will be able to:

1. Gain access to the students for witnessing and discipling, as well as see many decide to serve the Lord and enter Bible college or complete the Online Bible Institute.
2. Volunteer time to the university to help them with English in exchange for someone who can help our team with the Ilongo language.
3. Find other open doors both in and outside of the Philippines through their Institute of Languages.
4. Find the credentialed help necessary to reopen the academy at Gospel Baptist Church in Bacolod pastored by Missionary Charlie Vest.
