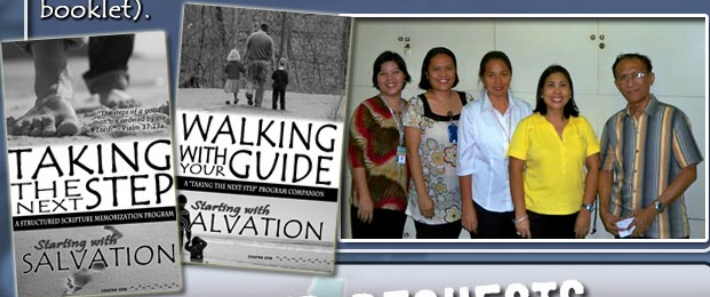

Priscilla was able to spend some time talking with Annie who had a basic knowledge of Jesus from her Catholic background but learned this day how she could know for sure she'd be with Jesus for eternity by trusting Him alone for her salvation. Priscilla said, "She thanked me several times for talking to her."
