"I'm Vilma Q. Magbanva, a widow. I have 4 kids, 2 boys and 2 girls. My husband died Oct. 6, 2004 of heart failure. When my husband died, I had to work for my kids. I left my kids with my in-laws and went to Qatar, Dubai, and Kuwait. I was gone for 6 years. I came back home on September 6, 2010, and on Saturday, September 18, I met Pastor Jason. That afternoon, I saw Pastor Jason preaching to the children about the message of God, and he has a Bible study every Saturday in our place. I was interested to listen to the Word of God, so I sat and listened to him talking. After he finished the Bible study, he encouraged me to receive Jesus and visit the church. I received Jesus that day and went to church the next day. On October 10, 2010, I decided to be baptized."
